

FACT SHEET 4 VEHICLE ACCESS AND PARKING

Where permission to use the plant vehicles is granted, the Hirer shall ensure that the operation of all vehicles complies with Health and Safety procedures. The Hirer shall ensure that all plant operators are competent, experienced and in possession of the appropriate qualification, licence or certificate.

Conduct Of Drivers In Park

DO

- Keep to vehicle access / egress routes previously agreed with the Parks Operations Manager.
- Keep to the surfaced paths unless you have permission to drive on the grass.
- Keep within the speed limit of 5 mph (walking pace).
- Turn on your hazard lights.
- Give way to all pedestrians and dogs. Stop when necessary.
- Obey the instructions of the Open Spaces Manager.

DO NOT

- Drive between parents and small children or dog owners and their dogs.
- Drive close behind people to make them move.
- Be impatient, aggressive or rude.
- Drive on the grass without permission and when permission is given use the paved areas to access the grass area, do not drive straight across the grass as a short cut.
- Overtake any moving vehicles.
- Reverse the vehicle

Vehicle Parking

Only essential vehicles shall be allowed to visit or park on event sites. The number of vehicles shall be agreed prior to the event with the Open Spaces Manager and the Hirer shall provide the Open Spaces Manager with a list of owner's details on request.

All other vehicles shall park in public car parks. The Hirer shall note that public car parks run a Pay and Display system, and any vehicle that parks in public car parks shall abide by the regulations clearly marked on the pay and display machines.
